**Directions:** In the book *Voices in St. Augustine*, Joey Johnson used the Internet to learn more about a house in St. Augustine, Florida. Using the Internet to obtain information on all kinds of topics can be fun, as well as educational. Here are some additional websites that relate to St. Augustine. See if you can find the answers to these questions by exploring these websites.

1. On the **City of St. Augustine's** official website at [www.citystaug.com](http://www.citystaug.com), click on the *Visiting* section and go to *Start Your Visit Here*. How many days a year is the Visitors Information Center (VIC) open?
2. At this same website, [www.citystaug.com](http://www.citystaug.com), click on the *Visiting* section again and go to *Parking*. Why are the streets so narrow in many sections of downtown St. Augustine?
3. At the [www.oldcity.com](http://www.oldcity.com) website, what kind of information will you find on *Where to Stay*?
4. At that same website [www.oldcity.com](http://www.oldcity.com), what kinds of things can you find under *Things To Do*?
5. One of the places people like to visit in St. Augustine is the **Castillo de San Marcos** which is a national park. The National Park Service has a website for its parks. The website for the Castillo de San Marcos is [www.nps.gov/casa/index.htm](http://www.nps.gov/casa/index.htm). Go to that website to learn how children can get a *Junior Ranger badge*.
6. How much does it cost for children under the age of 15 to visit the Castillo. (Hint: go to the **Castillo de San Marcos** website to *Plan Your Visit* under the *Basic Information*. You will have to click on one more link to find that fee.)
7. In the book Joey tours the **Ximenez-Fatio House**. Go to its website at [www.ximenezfatiohouse.org](http://www.ximenezfatiohouse.org) to find out what local material was used in building the house. You will find the answer at *Our Story*.
8. The **St. Augustine Record** is the local newspaper for St. Augustine and its website is [www.staugustine.com](http://www.staugustine.com). Name three kinds of information you can find on this website.
9. The Oldest House Museum is operated by the **St. Augustine Historical Society**. Go to <https://www.saintaugustinehistoricalsociety.org/> to find out how often the daily tours run for the museum.
10. The **St. Augustine Historical Society** website also has a link to the *Research Library*. What kinds of items do they have in their collection of historical documents?
