**Directions:** In the book *Lost in Boston*, the Johnson family visits Boston, Massachusetts, one of America's most historic cities. To learn more about the places they visit, use the Internet to answer the following questions.

1. Like Joey, if you're going to visit **Boston** and want to plan your trip before you leave, you can go to [www.bostonusa.com](http://www.bostonusa.com) to find all kinds of valuable information. List two kinds of information you can find on that website.
2. Many people from other countries like to visit Boston. That same website at [www.bostonusa.com](http://www.bostonusa.com) can be *translated* into other languages. Name one of those languages.
3. Joey, Bobby and Katy learn about **the Duck Tours** in Chapter 3. Go to their website at <https://www.bostonducktours.com/>. There are three *Departure* places where you can catch one of the Duck Tours. List one of them.
4. Katy visits the bronze ducklings in the Boston Public Garden that were made famous in the book ***Make Way for Ducklings***. Who is the author of that book? (You can go to [www.Amazon.com](http://www.Amazon.com) and search for the author's name by using the book's title.)
5. The Johnsons follow The Freedom Trail to the **Paul Revere House** in Boston's North End. Find Paul Revere's *Biography* on the website [www.paulreverehouse.org](http://www.paulreverehouse.org) and tell where he was born.
6. The **Old North Church** played a significant role in the colonists' rebellion against the British troops. It is the oldest surviving church building in Boston. Go to <https://oldnorth.com/> to *Learn* when the church was built. (Check out *Our History*.)
7. The Johnson family tours the **USS Constitution** in Boston Harbor. Go to the USS *Constitution* Museum at <https://ussconstitutionmuseum.org/> to see who owns that ship today. Go to *Visit* and then to *Plan Your Visit*.
8. The **City of Boston** website, [www.boston.gov](http://www.boston.gov), offers all kinds of information for its citizens. Name two kinds of information that can be found there.
9. **Harvard University**, [www.harvard.edu](http://www.harvard.edu), is the oldest institution of higher education in the United States. Go to *About Harvard* and *Harvard at a Glance* to learn when it was established.
10. Joey finally gets to go to a Red Sox game. Find the official website for the **Boston Red Sox** at [www.mlb.com/redsox](http://www.mlb.com/redsox). Now find the address for Fenway Park.
